Quickly and easily order your birth certificate online at: [www.ontario.ca/government/birth-certificates](http://www.ontario.ca/government/birth-certificates). Processing time is only 15 business days, with a service guarantee.

Children under the age of 16 require a certified copy of their birth registration (long form birth certificate) in order to apply for a passport. A certified copy of a birth registration can be ordered online at: [www.ontario.ca/government/birth-certificates](http://www.ontario.ca/government/birth-certificates).

Our constituency office can help to expedite a replacement birth certificate needed urgently for reasons such as travel or employment. The Office of the Registrar General requires proof of urgency, such as plane tickets or hotel reservations. Each person's request is unique.
